1. Rosemary called the meeting to order at 4:30.

Archie moved to accept the minutes from 5/28 and 5/26. Shirley seconded and the minutes were approved.

- d. The final copy of the Personnel manual was distributed and Rosemary will give them to all of the employees. The staff will be attending harassment training with all Town employees on June 3.
- 3. Rosemary attended the Friends meeting and brought them up to date on our search for a new library director. The land has been sold for \$37,500.
- 4. There was a question regarding adult movies being shown on Friday afternoons. Azra explained that the schedule was set up by Sandy and she would like to continue until the end of June.

Lucille reported that Sandy Safran has offered to donate money for adult and children's art classes during the summers. Rosemary will contact her.
