1. Secretary's report accepted.

2. Treasurers report presented.

3. Librarian's report:

- Sandy reported that Azra Karabegoric has accepted the position of Children's Librarian. All necessary paperwork has been filled out and we are waiting for the background check report.
- The roof repairs were done. There is a seam on the outside of the building where the new and old meet that has developed a crack and should be fixed. Wendy will ask Brakley to take a look at it.

- The town budget committee voted to reduce the proposed Library budget bottom line by \$10,689 leaving the bottom line at \$155,203.

- Sandy reported that the no smoking signs have arrived.
